

Intentional Communities

WHAT IS IT ?

Intentional community is a place where individuals live together and communally pursue depth with Jesus.

The purpose:

- Becoming more of who God intended you to be (Eph 4:22-24) – **Identity**
- Articulating God’s work in your life (Rom 12:2) – **Articulation**
- Understanding and engaging the good works God prepared for you (Eph 2:10) – **Participation**

The process:

- One year timeframe from initial move-in date
- Weekly participation in a Solidarity CFR (context for relationship)
- Monthly or twice a month house meeting to articulate your experiences
- Discipleship Relationships: in a relationship where someone is mentoring you and then finding someone else to speak truth into their life
- Giving: using your time, your gifting, and your resources for the Kingdom

The participant:

Participants must exhibit (1) a certain level of personal and spiritual maturity, (2) commitment to the intentional community covenant and process, and (3) movement towards God and growth.
